

From Buffalo take QEW to Hwy 403 at Oakville. Continue on Hwy 403 to Hwy 401. Take Hwy 401 to Hwy 400 North to Barrie. If coming from Detroit take Hwy 401

The roads Leading to Chaudiere Lodge

Hwy 400 North. At Barrie take Hwy 69 towards Parry Sound. Beyond Parry Sound cross the French River bridge, and turn North on Hwy 64 to Noelville. Take Hwy 64 through Monetville until Dokis Reserve rd. Take Dokis Reserve Rd. to Dokis Marina (17 miles). Chaudiere is 1.5 miles from Dokis Village. From Northerly points take Hwy 17 to Verner and proceed South on Hwy 64 to Dokis Reserve Road.
